The Northern Nevada jurisdictions will likely be adopting the 2018 I-codes within one year. The purpose of this seminar is to highlight many of the significant changes that will occur in the 2018 IBC from the 2015 version. Because Northern Nevada is currently enforcing the 2012 IBC, time will also be allotted to highlight some of the significant changes that were made from the 2012 IBC to the 2015 version. Some of these changes include new methods of calculating allowable heights and areas, new deck and balcony provisions, changes to the referenced structural standards, and much more.
