COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course focuses on the accessibility requirements of the 2018 IBC and ICC/ANSI A117.1-2009. It includes scoping requirements for existing and historic buildings per the 2018 IEBC. The course discusses accessible requirements for recreational facilities including pools, miniature golf, etc. It will also review accessible means of egress requirements. The class will not include information for dwelling units.
