

2018 IEBG: An Introduction

How well do you understand the International Existing Building Code? This course will provide a general overview of the 2018 IEBC and will clarify how the code is laid out. Requirements for repairs, alterations, additions, moved structures and historic structures will be addressed. Specific triggers for mandatory structural, fire safety, and accessibility triggers will be discussed. Numerous examples will be

used to ensure attendees can apply the IEBC requirements to multiple types of projects.
