Bob began introductions:

November 7th in Council Chambers for Kickoff Meeting. 1:30-2:30 in council chambers.

Last email blast coming for attendance or membership for committee makeup coming up. Deadline is 11/30/23.

UPC, UMC, IPC, and IBC can get started because the books are published. IEBC as well. NEC 2023 can get started as well.

- Code Adoption Process Overview of process was given.
- Timeline General timeline was reviewed.

Bob spoke on the timelines and indicated that they were tentative but represent our committed timeline.

Bob brought up that City of Reno Fire has initiated a cost study on SFR residences being fire-sprinklered above 5000sqft. Candace brought in a discussion point regarding additions. Per NRS it must be included. Mark pointed out that Sparks and Reno could adopt but the exemption could be left in for other jurisdictions to be decided. Scott pointed out that there could be some water access issues for certain jurisdictions. Leave clause for exemption was the general consensus and to let the fire department handle this issue.

Bob pointed out that currently the IFC is not available. Fire jurisdictions will handle them individually.

• Bylaws – Bob asked that the committee members review these on their own time.

Bob detailed all of the bylaws and noted all of the committee responsibilities as well as steering committee responsibilities.

Mark noted the bylaws include the opportunity for a proxy to attend and vote in their stead.

• Technical Committee Update – Committee Roster was discussed with notification of deadlines. Phases of committees to start now and some start when the I-Codes are published.

Bob indicated that he would be having set meetings with the chairs and secretaries of the technical committees regarding our processes and expectations.

Grace period for code adoption being 7/1/24 with effective date of 01/01/25 was discussed with notice to industry of grace period so that they have the opportunity to adjust to the new code requirements.
