- Churchill County has a new submittal system for permits.
- Lyon County has several Commercial projects, and an increase in Single-Family New construction.
- Washoe County has a Permit Tech position posted, and a potential building inspector job being posted soon.
- Bureau Veritas is seeing an uptick in Commercial and Industrial plan review.
- Sparks has lots of projects happening by Legends, however their Planning Department has been slow. Their Building Official position still has not been filled.
- Douglas County has been busy with a new Judicial Center, new hotel, and hospital remodel.
- Storey County has an Industrial Park that is being worked on and is seeing a downturn in residential permits.
